MUNAIM Staff and Secretariat will be checking for incorrect clothing and will have no tolerance for those who do not abide the dress code. Any failure to follow this dress code will result in a written warning.

MEN: All men should wear a suit and tie at all times. Formal shoes shall be worn along with black, gray, or blue socks. Men are only allowed to take off their suit's jacket once the respective Director or Moderator has allowed it only for the session.

WOMEN: All women should use a formal dress, a suit, or a formal blouse and skirt. Skirts shall not be more than THREE (3) centimeters above the knee. All shall be worn with formal shoes.

MUNAIM Staff and Secretariat forbids the use of miniskirts, low "v" neck blouses, slippers or bare foot, and thin straps for women. As for men, it is forbidden to use t-shirts instead of formal shirts. For both, it is forbidden the use of jeans, shorts, tennis shoes, and any other clothing that is not considered formal clothing.
